In Drajit Gupta, MP, leader of the CPI in the House of the People, Political Bureau member and secretary of the CPI Central Committee, vice president of the All-India Trade Union Congress: "...For all fighters against imperialism, all fighters for national independence, all fighters for democratic rights and for social progress and all fighters for peace, this country of yours, Vietnam, has become a place of pilgrimage and we have come here also to perform that pilgrimage because the soil of Vietnam is [words indistinct] which is soaked with the blood of the previous standing fighters that the world has known.

But this morning, I am ashamed to say, I saw proletarian internationalism trampled underfoot on your soil. I was surprised to see that the targets of the Chinese aggression was wanton destruction. Medical hospitals, schools, and factories of the working class...I was very glad to hear from the chairman of the Foreign Relations (Commission) of your party that you always distinguish between the Chinese people and the rulers of China. People create history. I'm sure that the Chinese people one day will definitely overthrow the Chinese rulers and those who are now stabbing in the back of their friends of only yesterday".

And at last China will be historically compelled to see reason and bow to the peace-loving people of the world. May I assure you, brothers and sisters, of our solidarity with you and unreserved support for your relentless struggle for national sovereignty, territorial integrity and independence, for peace and progress and a just world order free all kinds of exploitation".

COUNCIL OF MINISTERS DECISION ON INVENTORY OF ASSETS

[Text] The Council of Ministers recently decided to organize a general inventory in order to reevaluate the assets of primary units of various state economic sectors. The decision specified:

Implementing the party Central Committee's sixth plenum resolution, the Council of Ministers has decided to conduct a general inventory to reevaluate the assets of every primary unit and economic sector of the state in order to better control all existing materials and equipment of all sectors and localities, and on this basis, to secure accurate grounds for the formulation of the state 5-year 1981-85 plan and to thoroughly understand the guidelines for fully using and developing all potentials to accelerate production.

Specific Purposes and Requirements Of the General Inventory

As regards primary units, we must firmly grasp the quantity, quality and real value of all existing assets and materials in order to accurately appraise production capacity, the rates of using and developing the output of machinery and equipment, to determine in a relatively unified and accurate manner the prices of all types of assets, materials and equipment and to carry out the principle of unifying prices under various conditions of production and business operations in 1980, thereby correctly determining capital—fixed and liquid assets—now placed under the managerial control of primary units.

In connection with this general inventory to reevaluate assets, primary units should devise plans to further improve their management of assets in order to protect and rationally use their assets and to properly deal with cases of stockpiled assets or use of assets. All cases that go beyond the authority and ability of primary units to deal with must be reported to higher echelons which will create conditions for primary units to deal with them for the best results.
