JOINT SOYUZ SPACE CREW VISITS HO CHI MINH CITY

[Text] Hanoi, 4 Sep (VNA)--The Soviet-Vietnamese space crew led by Lieutenant General V.A. Shatalov, deputy commander of the Soviet Air Force in charge of cosmonaut training, arrived in Ho Chi Minh City on September 2 for a visit to the city and the Vung Tau-Con Dao special sector.

The crew, accompanied by Professor Nguyen Van Hieu, deputy director of the Vietnam Institute of Science and vice-chairman of the Vietnam Commission for Cosmic Research; Major General Vu Xuan Chiem, vice minister of national defence, and Soviet Ambassador to Vietnam B. N. Chaplin.

It was warmly welcomed from Tan Son Mhut Airport to the Thong Mhat conference hall where more than 10,000 representatives of the city people, public officers, mass organizations and armed forces rallied at a grand meeting in its honour.

NHAN DAN CONDEMNS WESTERN PLOT TO USE CYPRUS AS BASE

After denouncing the U.S. and other Western countries for scheming to use Cyprus for a base for spying against the Soviet Union and the other peace-loving countries in the Mediterranean and the Indian Ocean, the paper says: "The present situation in Cyprus is basically not a problem of conflict between two different communities on the island. There can't be an early solution to the problem so long as foreign troops still are stationed there and the U.S. and the NATO military bloc still maintain the present partition of the country and use Cyprus as a jumping-off place for interventionist and aggressive activities in the Middle East and the eastern areas of the Mediterranean."

The paper recalls that President Kiprianou has many times called on his people, both Greek-born and Turkish-born, and all democratic and patriotic forces to unite in the struggle against imperialist interference to defend national independence, territorial integrity and the non-aligned policy of the republic. "The Cypriot's struggle to defend independence, sovereignty, territorial integrity and national concord is continuing," the paper concluded.
