India to add 100-150 satellites in 3 yrs to boost safety: Isro

CHENNAI: India will add another 100-150 satellites to cover the entire country over the next three years as part of enhancing border security, Isro chairman V Narayanan said. Currently, India operates about 55 satellites and for a country which has a vast border and 7.500 km of shoreline, it is not sufficient, he said. "We need a lot of satellites to protect our borders. In three years, we will be adding another 100-150 satellites," he said
